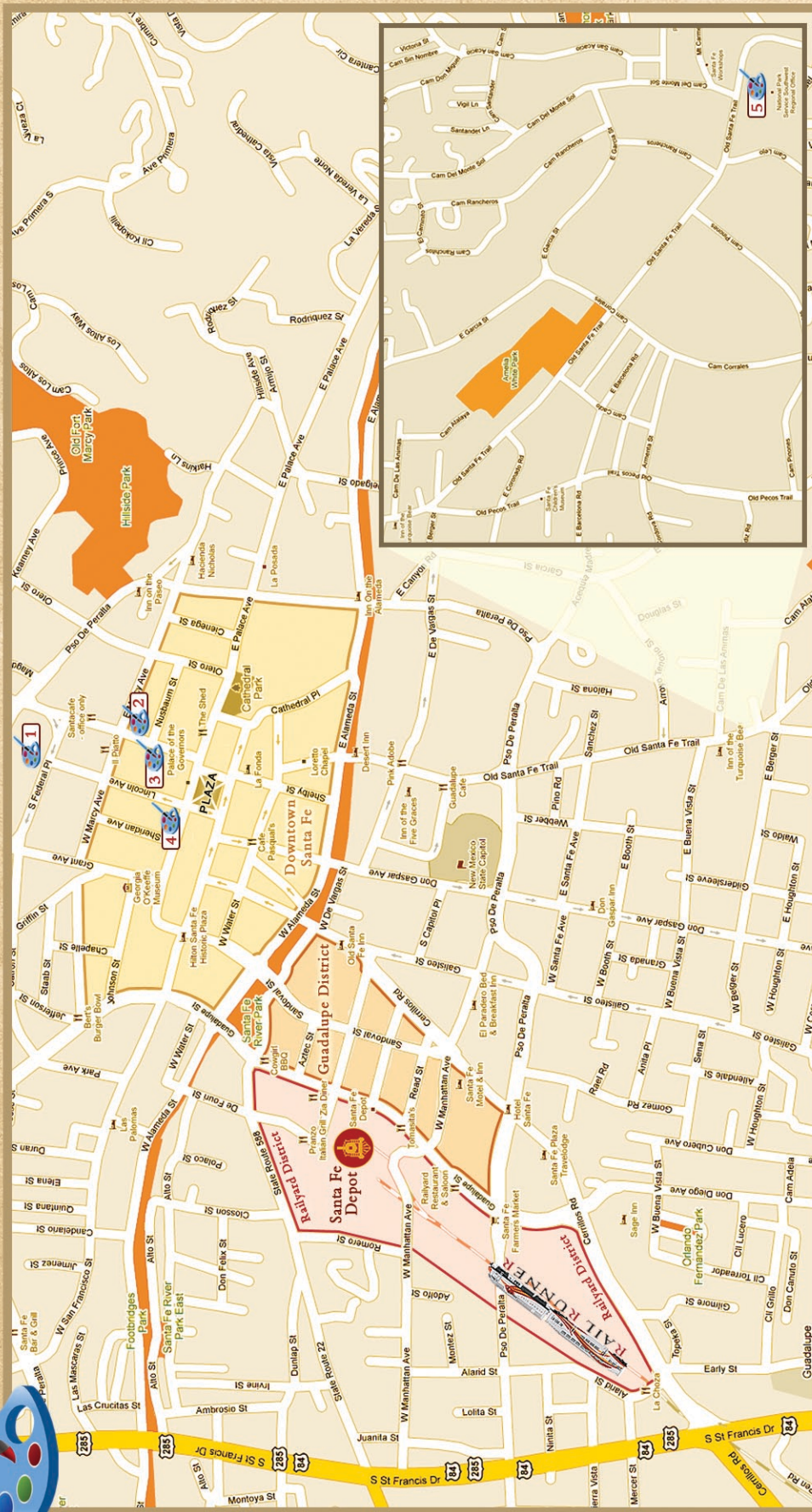


# New Deal Art Legacy Tour
